

6-Week Summer Social Skills Groups (ages 3-13)

Groups focus on building necessary skills in a focused and supported group environment. Each week offers a unique theme, which allows children to play and learn together while improving social skills. Skills worked on:

- Cooperation during play
- Sharing
- Following rules and directions
- Personal space and boundaries
- Decreasing melt downs during play interactions

Summer Social Skills program is a partnership with UNM's OT graduate school: Fieldwork I Psychosocial class. Part-time contracting for summer group sessions is separate.

Program and Team

Our occupational therapy program provides a holistic, client centered, multi-disciplinary approach to meet the needs of our clients. Our team utilizes trauma informed approaches to address concerns across all areas of development, including: social, emotional, behavioral, cognitive, and motor delays. Our practitioners use play-based techniques to address areas of concern in a fun and innovative way that invites collaboration from the client, family, and other team members. Skills evaluated and assessed:

- Gross Motor
- Fine Motor skills
- Eye-Hand Coordination
- Psychosocial Emotional Skills
- Communication/ Social Skills
- Self-Regulation
- Behavior Management
- ADLs: eating, sleeping, self-help skills, and toileting
